Raising babies takes special handling and special food. It isn't as easy as just going to the grocery store for milk. Many require special formulas that are up to 100 times more expensive than cow's milk. That is why we hope you will become a Sanctuary Supporter! Save the Babies is our annual spring fundraiser for the infants that will be left in our care March through May. They will be raised and released from June to August.

[Animal Sponsors](#) support us by an annual or monthly donation. These funds go to help feed and care for our permanent residents, which includes 6 Western cougars, 3 Eastern panthers (the most rare and endangered cat in the world!), 7 American black bears, 1 Canadian lynx, 3 ferrets, 2 squirrels, 2 flying squirrels (endangered in Georgia), 2 raccoons, 1 groundhog, 2 opossums, 1 chinchilla, 1 wallaby, 1 screech owl, 1 red-tailed hawk, 1 Macaw, 8 snakes, and 3 spiders. All of these critters require food, cages, care, and the support of people like you.

However, if we don't have your support, we may have to turn a lot of babies away. That means they will not survive. Please don't let this happen.
